




LESSON 3

- the properties of material determine its usefulness. It also identify which materials can be used for certain purposes and how materials can be discarded.

- The 5Rs are strategies in waste management.
 - Reducing means using less of a certain material and using alternatives.
 - Reusing means finding another purpose for materials that have already been used.
 - Recycling means producing a new product out of discarded materials.
 - Recovering means making the most out of the waste by generating energy from it.
 - Repairing means fixing broken things so that they can be used again.
- The 5Rs help in minimizing garbage, which is the main cause of pollution.
